Some writing tips

- ⇒ **Plan:** Plan your composition. Think of ideas and organise them into your plan outline.
- ⇒ **Outline:** Use the outline given below to write down your ideas. The composition will have three parts:
 - An introduction
 - Body of information/details
 - Conclusion
- ⇒ **Introduction:** Start your writing with a very interesting sentence that will catch the reader's attention.
- ⇒ **Body:** Your story here will contain more than one paragraph, so there is more than one point. It will have linking words with the points you want to discuss, such as topic sentences, explanations and examples.
- ⇒ **Conclusion:** Close your composition with a final paragraph briefly outlining the points you have made, like an overview of the main ideas.
- ⇒ **Check your work:** Go through your work once you have finished and proof-read it. Ask yourself: are my points related to the topic? Check for grammar, spelling, commas, etc.
